Our outreach hosted a first aid clinic, reading glasses, prayer, sharing the Gospel, construction, children's ministry, and we fed 100's of hot dogs to the community.



Tijuana is home to so many broken people who just need to know that they are LOVED. It reminds me of the parable Jesus told us in Luke 14. "But when you give a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind, and you will be blessed."
